Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of New Zealand and the Government of the Republic of Korea on the Establishment of a Working Holiday Scheme, done at Wellington on the 21st of April 1999 (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement").

I further have the honour to confirm that the Government of New Zealand will take the following measures under the Agreement from the same day as the *Free Trade Agreement between the Republic of Korea and New Zealand* enters into force:

1. The Government of New Zealand will issue up to three thousand (3000) multiple entry working holiday visas each year to eligible nationals of the Republic of Korea.
2. The Government of New Zealand will require the nationals of the Republic of Korea who stay in New Zealand under the Working Holiday Scheme not to engage in permanent employment.
3. The Government of New Zealand will permit the above-mentioned nationals of the Republic of Korea to enrol in one or more courses of training or study of up to six (6) months' duration in total during their stay in New Zealand under the Working Holiday Scheme.
4. The Government of New Zealand will require the above-mentioned nationals of the Republic of Korea to hold comprehensive medical insurance valid throughout the duration of their stay in New Zealand under the Working Holiday Scheme.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Your Excellency's letter of today's date.

I further have the honour to confirm that the Government of the Republic of Korea will take the following measures under the Agreement between the Government of New Zealand and the Government of the Republic of Korea on the Establishment of a Working Holiday Scheme from the same day the *Free Trade Agreement between the Republic of Korea and New Zealand* enters into force:

1. The Government of the Republic of Korea will issue up to three thousand (3000) multiple entry working holiday visas each year to eligible nationals of New Zealand.
2. The Government of the Republic of Korea will require the nationals of New Zealand who stay in the Republic of Korea under the Working Holiday Scheme not to engage in permanent employment.
3. The Government of the Republic of Korea will permit the above-mentioned nationals of New Zealand to enrol in one or more courses of training or study of up to six (6) months' duration in total during their stay in the Republic of Korea under the Working Holiday Scheme.
4. The Government of the Republic of Korea will require the above-mentioned nationals of New Zealand to hold comprehensive medical insurance valid throughout the duration of their stay in the Republic of Korea under the Working Holiday Scheme.
